Eastern Gathering 2013 Proposal

East Anglian Permaculture Gathering 2013
July 19-21st. Ringsfield Hall Eco Centre, Beccles, Suffolk or Farmer Paul's Field at Date in June tbc

3 miles from Beccles Train station, this rural centre has 50 beds and regularly hosts groups. With additional camping and a warren of interesting outdoor areas the venue can look after a gathering with minimal additional infrastructure. A permaculture plan of the site was created by Thomas Ramirez in the past and a legacy of the event would (could) be to re design certain areas or the whole site. There are interesting local visits that could also be arranged.

Or a well used festival field with some facilities like water, compost loos etc. Farmer intersted in having permaculture audit and designs. Not easy by public transport.

Theme: 30 years of Permaculture in the East. We aim to contact those people in the area who have developed permaculture in the past. Possibly film them if they can't come to the gathering.

What we need from the Association:

Thanks for the templates which already useful. We would like advice on the following:

- booking the event via your website, can membership to PCA be included?
- Insurance? There is venue insurance, but just in case, via you?
- Website: a page off your site?
- List of members from the past 30 years or at least some contacts from your memories.
- Things to sell like books from the office.
- A member of staff to show Eastern people.
- Any useful kit
- Help to pay the initial outlay. To be recovered from the payments made. Spreadsheet to follow. £1-2,000 would be good.

Functions of the Event:

- celebrate 30 years of permaculture in the East
- to have some fun : -)
- to create or strengthen links between permaculture practitioners in the eastern region (defined as Essex, Suffolk, Norfolk and Cambridgeshire)
- Support Current people/ Projects/ local Community
- Income to pass onto other projects
- Family Friendly

Costings:

- Venue was offered at £40 per bed (50 beds) = £2,000. Additional 50 campers permitted tbc Or on field: £2/person/night Thursday to Sunday 3 nights 100people = £600 plus £400 for extras like margues and facilitites.
 - Food, caterers to be investigated. Idea of a feast of our own produce on the Saturday. PCS guidelines: (£2 brekkie, £5 lunch and £7 dinner = £28) Im sure this can be reduced. Leaves a maximum of £2800 if 100 people.

Or on Field: Outdoor catering equipment needed.

- Infrastructure, possible additional tents? Keen to respect fairshares but £200 max we expect delegates to provide some additional structures.
- Entertainment would be sought locally. Keen to respect fairshares but £300 max. Should be provided by delegates.
- Permaculture Association Membership. Separate costing.
- Legal, Insurance (site has 5milion liability), Website, Booking Costs Can PCA help here?
- Contingency?
- Surplus to create a seed fund/ pay for delegate to international conference.
- Course Tutors if introduction course Friday day time?

Cost to Delegates worked out in budget folder but summary below:

Initial ideas are £62 minimum adult delegate rate, £37 child.

- £20 cash surplus if not car sharing.

Revised pricing Adults £60-£100 sliding, Day tickets optional
